Who's the author?

Classical View: written by **Daniel** (6th Century. B.C) to the captive Israelites

Critical View: written by **an unknown Jew** (2nd Century B.C) to the captive Israelites

because of some historical facts such as

- 1) difference between Dan. 1:1 and Jer. 25:1
- 2) Belshazar's father: Nabonidus

What kind of book is it? History + Prophecy + Apocalypse

History and Prophecy: Ch. 1 -6 in the court.

Prophecy and Apocalypse: Ch. 7-12 in visions.

Written in two languages: Hebrew and Aramaic

Hebrew: Chs. 1-2:4a and 8-12

Aramaic: Chs. 2:4b-7
