2. Intro

a. Typology: Relation between the Old and the New Testament ([bibleandtheology.net](http://bibleandtheology.net))

Types such as events, persons, and institutions in the O.T **prefigure** the antitypes in the N.T.

Types in the O.T and antitypes in the N.T are similar but antitypes are **greater** than the types.

Antitypes complete or fulfill the types.

Example) 1 Peter 3:20-21, 2 Peter 2:15, 1 Corinthians 10:1-4, and 15:45

Question. Can you tell any types in the O.T that may be related to the antitypes in the N.T?

b. Prophecies in the Old and the New Testaments

The prophecies in the Old Testament are fulfilled in the New Testament.

The prophecies in the New Testament are not subordinate to the ones in the Old Testament.

c. Daniel and Revelation

Daniel sees Rome as the last earthly kingdom before the kingdom of God.

(Dan. 7:11-14, 25-27, 9:27, 11:40-45, and 12:1-3)

The book of Revelation

has similar descriptions to Daniel about Rome and the end of the world (13:1-10)  
but shows the new and complete revelation (antitypes) on the end of the world.

Examples) The Son of Man in Daniel 7:13-14, 10:5-6 and Revelation 1:7, 13, 14:14.

Thrones in Daniel 7:9-10, 9:27 and Revelation 4:1-6, 20:4

Beast in Daniel 7:3, 21 and Revelation 11:7, 13:1, 17:12-14

Can you see the similarities and differences between Daniel and Revelation?
