Prelude of Jesus' death in the beginning (2:19-20 and 3:6) Jesus' title "King" (15:2, 9, 12, 18, 26, and 32) Jesus as atonement (8:35 and 15:31)

d. In Luke

Jesus as Passover Meal for the new Covenant (22:7, 14-15, and 20)

e. In John (12:23-32) Glorification (23), the way to eternal life (24-26), obedience to the Father (27-30), judgment (31-32)
