Jesus taught about prayers: 6:5-15, 11:25-27, 26:38-45

c. Luke

15 prayers of Jesus are found in Luke.

Jesus who prays: after baptism in 3:21, solitary place in 5:16, before calling 12 disciples in 6:12, before Peter's confession in 9:16, at transfiguration in 9:29, after mission trip in 10:21, before teaching the Lord's Prayer in 11:1, prayer for Peter in 22:31, at Gethsemane in 22:41, and on the cross in 23:46

Jesus who teaches prayers: parable of a friend at night in 11:5, "ask, seek, and knock" in 11:9, parable of a widow in 18:1-8, prayers of a Pharisee and a tax collector in 18:10, and at Gethsemane in 22:40
