- 2. Intro: The Spirit of the Lord ("Wind of YHWH") upon the Judges

The phrase "Spirit of the Lord" appears first in the book of Judges.

What does the "Spirit of YHWH" do in the book of Judges?

a. Othniel the perfect judge

"The Spirit of the Lord **came upon** (*haya*) him, so that **he became** Israel's judge and went to war." (3:10a)

b. Gideon the afraid judge

"But the spirit of the Lord **took possession of** (*labas*) Gideon; and he sounded the trumpet.." (6:34) *Labas*: to clothe, or to be clothed

c. Jephthah the opportunistic judge (11:6 and 12)

"Then the Spirit of the LORD came upon (*haya*) Jephthah...And Jephthah made a vow to the LORD.." (11:29-30)

d. Samson the selfish playboy judge

"and the Spirit of the LORD began to stir (paam: to impel) him." (13:25)

"The spirit of the Lord rushed on (zhaleach: to rush) him and he tore the lion apart..." (14:6)

"Then the spirit of the Lord rushed on (zhaleach) him...He killed thirty men of the town..." (14:19)

"...the spirit of the Lord rushed on (*zhaleach*) him, and the ropes that were on his arms became like flax that has caught fire, and his bonds melted off his hands. Then he found a fresh jawbone of a donkey... with it he killed a thousand men." (15:14-15)

How do you understand the Holy Spirit's coming upon the judges?
