3) highest heaven (Deut. 10:14)

God's dwelling place (Deuteronomy 26:15), reigning the earth (Psalm 99:1)

God speaks from heaven (Deuteronomy 4:36)

The Son of Man will come from heaven (Daniel 7:13-14)

There will be new heavens just like new earth (Isaiah 65:17 and 66:22)
